A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, IN SUPPORT OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH'S CONTINUED FUNDING FOR THE KACHEMAK BAY CAMPUS.

WHEREAS, A proposal to suspend funding for the Kenai Peninsula College is under consideration in the Kenai Peninsula Borough Mayor's proposed 2012 Budget; and

WHEREAS, The proposed suspension of funding for the Kenai Peninsula College would directly affect the Kachemak Bay Campus, resulting in the termination of critical services and instruction to the students; and

WHEREAS, The Kachemak Bay Campus provides opportunity for post secondary education for more than 500 students, with an emphasis on smaller classes and individual attention; and
