- 92% of Homer residents are high school graduates, or higher, compared to 80% in this category nationwide. 29% have earned bachelor's degrees, or higher, compared to 24% nationwide. (2000 Census data)
- Homer is known for excellent public schools (including charter schools), home-school options, and career-oriented and liberal arts instruction at the Kachemak Bay Campus of UAA-Kenai Peninsula College.

#8: Affordability

- Considering everything it has to offer at "the end of the road," Homer is affordable. The overall cost of living is virtually identical to that of Anchorage, and housing is considerably less expensive.

#9: Room for growth and emphasis on smart growth

- There is room for new development both within and outside Homer's city limits.
- Homer's population is growing slowly, creating new opportunities for entrepreneurs while ensuring that public services keep up with population growth.
