ORDINANCE 80-6

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE TRANSPORT OF GARBAGE UNSECURED IN A VEHICLE AND REPEALER OF ARTICLE III, SECTION 5.300.1.(F); TO PROHIBIT FLIGHT TO AVOID ARREST AND TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, in conjunction with a review and updating of the Homer City Code, provisions relating to police powers and the public welfare have been found to be needed,

THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Chapter 5, Article X is hereby created to read as follows:

ARTICLE X. -- TRANSPORTATION OF GARBAGE OR TRASH.

Sec. 5-1000.1. TRANSPORTATION OF GARBAGE OR TRASH. No person shall transport garbage, trash or other materials in vehicles unless such materials have been secured to prevent scattering or spillage. Article III - Public Nuisances, Sec. 5-300.1.(f) is hereby repealed.

Section 2, Chapter 9, Article II, POLICE DEPARTMENT is hereby amended by adding the following:

Sec. 9-200.4. FLIGHT TO AVOID ARREST. No person shall intentionally evade a law officer following a request or command to stop. Such request maybe made verbally or by signal.

Section 3. Chapter 10, FIREARMS, of the Homer City Code is hereby repealed and reenacted to read:

Sec. 10-100.1. DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PROHIBITED. No person shall discharge a fire arm within the corporate limits of the City of Homer.

Sec. 10-100.2. SAME -- EXCEPTION. The prohibition of discharge of firearms shall not apply to a law officer in the performance of his duty, or to the use of target ranges authorized by the Chief of Police, or protection of life or property.

Sec. 10-100.3. SAME -- PENALTY. The violation of any provision contained in this article shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$300 and/or confiscation of the violator's firearm(s) upon order of the court.
