ORDINANCE 81-13

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT KAPINGEN SUBDIVISION UNIT 3 AKA PARK RESERVE AND OSCAR MUNSON SUBDIVISION LOT 9, IN THE POSSESSION OF THE CITY OF HOMER, SHALL BE DESIGNATED FOR PUBLIC USE AND PROVIDING FOR A SPECIFIC PUBLIC USE; FURTHER PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE HOMER CITY CODE UNDER SPECIAL AND LIMITED ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, there is a need for certain foreclosed properties to be utilized for public use, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public to employ these properties in the manner stated below,

THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. DEDICATION: The following foreclosed properties are hereby dedicated for public use by the City of Homer:



Section 2. SPECIFIC PURPOSES: The above, described properties shall be utilized in the following manner:


