WHEREAS, the expenditure of these funds was initiated by Ordinance 81-5, but not disbursed in the Fiscal Year 1980/81; and


WHEREAS, the City of Homer intends to complete the projects,

THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:


Section 1. That the City of Homer Federal Shared Revenue Fund Balance at June 30, 1981 be reappropriated as follows:
