ORDINANCE 84-1(a)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, PORTS AND HARBOR, OF  
THE HOMER CITY CODE, ENACTING SECTION 10.14, FISH DOCK  
FACILITY RATES, AND NAMING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS: the City of Homer has completed the construction of a new  
Fish Dock facility, and

WHEREAS: the new Fish Dock facility includes ice making, crane,  
vacuum fish unloading and ancillary equipment, and

WHEREAS: the operation and maintenance of the new facility will be  
carried out by the Port and Harbor Department, and

WHEREAS: the cost of operating and maintaining the new facility  
will be funded through user fees in accordance with the existing financial  
policy:

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

HCC Section 10.14.010 Schedule of Rates is hereby enacted to read:

- a) The following schedule of equipment rates shall be effected March 5,  
1984, through February 28, 1985.

SCHEDULE OF RATES

Card Access Fee:                      \$125 per year  
    \$40 per quarter  
    \$10 per individual occurrence

Equipment:

1. 2.5 Ton Crane                      \$10.00 first 50 hrs/mo  
    7.00 over 50 hrs/mo
2. 5.0 Ton Crane                      \$12.00 first 50 hrs/mo  
    8.00 over 50 hrs/mo
3. Fish Unloader                      \$325.00 per hour
4. Ice                                      \$45.00 per ton

- b) The minimum per hour charge for the cranes and fish unloader will be for  
15 minutes. Additional charges will be based upon additional increments  
of 15 minutes.

c) The rates for ancillary Fish Dock facilities are as follows:

| <u>Facility</u>            | <u>Rate</u>  |
|----------------------------|--|
| 1. Cash Buyer Shed         | \$200.00 per month annual use<br>\$250.00 per month semiannual |
| 2. Cold Storage            | 2.5¢ per pound<br>First month<br>1.0¢ per pound<br>Thereafter  |
| 3. Cold Storage Inspection | \$50.00 per hour<br>1.5 hours minimum                          |

HCC Section 10.14.020 Rules and Regulations:

- a) The City Administration shall enact and promulgate all necessary rules and regulations necessary to implement the schedule of rates and to collect Fish Dock revenues.
- b) The City Administration shall have printed a sufficient number of copies of the schedule of rates approved and adopted by the City Council, and the same shall be available to the public at the Offices of the Port Director, Harbormaster and City Clerk.
