ORDINANCE 84-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HOMER CITY CODE 17.04.060, IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS, IMPROVEMENT PLAN--OBJECTIONS AND REVISIONS, STATING OBJECTIONS MAY BE FILED NO LATER THAN 60 DAYS AFTER THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, AS 29.63.030 states objections to the improvement plan may be filed not less than 30 nor more than 60 days after publication of notice on a date specified by the Council; and,

WHEREAS, Homer City Code does not clearly state when the 60 day objection period begins;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:


Section 17.04.060 Improvement Plan -- Objections and Revisions is amended as follows:

(a.) The owner of property to be assessed may file an objection to the plan no later than sixty days after the public hearing required in subsection (c) of Section 17.04.050. At the end of the sixty days, if the owners of one half in value of the property to be benefitted have not objected, the Council may pass a resolution approving the plan and proceeding with the improvement.
