ORDINANCE 85-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1.64 AND CREATING  
CHAPTER 1.66 OF THE HOMER MUNICIPAL CODE DEFINING  
THE DEPARTMENTS OF PUBLIC WORKS AND COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, it is in the City's interest to reorganize, redefine, and initiate programs which will benefit the City in terms of greater efficiency, consolidation of programs, and better service to the community;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Chapter 1.64 of the Homer Municipal Code is hereby repealed in its entirety and re-enacted to read as follows:

Chapter 1.64

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

Sections:

1.64.010 Department of Public Works

1.64.010 Department of Public Works. The Department of Public Works is created which shall be headed by the Director of Public Works who shall be appointed by the City Manager for an indefinite term and shall be removable by the City Manager. The Department may be subdivided into divisions with their own superintendents or foremen as deemed necessary. The Director shall supervise such personnel as may be necessary to operate, maintain, inspect, engineer, and construct public facilities such as water systems distribution and treatment, sewer systems collection and treatment, cemeteries, Parks and Recreation facilities, streets and highways, Port and Harbor facilities, and all city owned rolling stock. (Prior Code 14-100.0)

Section 2. Chapter 1.66 of the Homer Municipal Code is hereby created to read:

Chapter 1.66

DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Sections:

1.66.010 Department of Community Development

1.66.010 Department of Community Development. The Department of Community Development is hereby created which shall be headed by the Director of Community Development who shall be appointed by the City Manager for an indefinite term and shall be removable by the City Manager. The Director shall supervise personnel as may be necessary to provide such services as personnel administration; city wide planning; zoning and platting; city permitting and inspection administration; cultural services such as Parks and Recreation and Library programs; administration of the Homer Advisory Planning Commission and the Homer Advisory Parks and Recreation Commission; major capital projects administration; economic development and city enhancement programs; and other such services or programs as designated by the City Manager.
