ORDINANCE 85-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1.74 OF THE HOMER  
MUNICIPAL CODE AS TO THE PROCEEDINGS AND DUTIES  
OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY PLANNING  
COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission is advisory on Parks and Recreation matters to City Council, Mayor and City Manager;

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission has recently considered and approved a number of amendments to Chapter 1.74, Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission of the Homer Municipal Code;

WHEREAS, the approved amendments are to be enacted in ordinance form;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 1.74.030 of the Homer Municipal Code is hereby amended to read:

1.74.030 Proceedings of commission. The Commission shall meet regularly once a month, and at the call of the Chairman. Permanent records or minutes shall be kept of commission proceedings and such minutes shall record the vote of each member upon every question. Every decision or finding shall immediately be filed in the office of the City Clerk, and shall be a public record open to inspection by any person. Every decision or finding shall be directed to the Mayor and City Council through the City Manager at the earliest possible date.

Section 2. Section 1.74.040 of the Homer Municipal Code is hereby amended to read:

1.74.040 Duties and responsibilities of Commission.

- a. It shall be the duty of the Commission to act in an advisory capacity to the City Manager and the City Council on the problems and development of park and recreation facilities within the City Service Area. Considerations of the Commission may include existing facilities, possible future development and recommendations on land use.
- b. Any recommendation the Commission may have regarding park and recreation facilities is to be directed to the Mayor and City Council through the City Manager.
- c. The Commission shall consider any specific proposal, problem or project as directed by the City Council.
- d. The City Council may at a future date expand or withdraw duties and responsibilities of the Commission.
