ORDINANCE 86-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, PORT AND HARBORS, OF
THE HOMER CITY CODE, REPEALING AND REENACTING SECTION
10.12.030, MOORING RATES.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer has appointed a Rate Tariff Task Force to study and prepare recommendations to establish rates and tariffs for the Homer Port, Fish Dock, and Harbor;

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has accepted the Rate Tariff Task Force recommendations and has agreed to begin implementation of the recommendations;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Homer Ordains:

Section 1. Section 10.12.030 MOORING RATES, of the Homer City Code is hereby repealed in its entirety and reenacted to read:

Sec. 10.12.030. MOORING RATES a. Any vessel utilizing the harbor for mooring shall be charged in accordance with the appropriate schedule. All mooring fees, reserved or transient, are paid to the City and shall be paid in advance for the period prescribed. Reserved and transient annual moorage may be paid in accordance with the Reserved and Transient Monthly Payment Plan. Payment for reserved moorage will only be accepted from reserved stall lessee.

b. The following schedule is effective at 12:01 a.m. the day immediately following passage of the ordinance codified in this chapter:

1. The annual moorage fee for reserved moorage and transient moorage privileges shall be eighteen and 00/100 dollars (\$18.00), per lineal foot, based on the length of the float assigned or the overall length of the vessel (including all hull attachments such as bowsprits, davits, dinghies, etc.), whichever is greater.


2. The semiannual rate for either reserved or transient moorage privileges shall be sixty six and six tenths percent (66.6%) of the applicable annual rate.

3. The quarterly rate for either reserved or transient moorage privileges shall be sixty six and six tenths percent (66.6%) of the applicable semiannual rate.


c. Transient daily vessels shall be charged at a rate of \$0.20 per lineal foot for the Winter and on the rate of \$0.40 per lineal foot for the Summer.

d. The reserved and annual payment plan allows annual moorage to be paid in seven consecutive payments. Monthly payment amounts shall be determined by dividing the annual moorage rate, plus 10% surcharge, by seven (7).


