ORDINANCE 88-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER AMENDING CHAPTER 8.08, ITINERANT OR TRANSIENT MERCHANT'S LICENSE BY REPEALING AND REENACTING SECTION 8.08.080, EXHIBITION OF LICENSE.

WHEREAS, there has become an increasing number of vendors within the City of Homer selling merchandise, door-to-door; and

WHEREAS, to protect the health and safety of the citizens of Homer it is necessary that itinerant or transient merchant's within Homer, exhibit their license prominently while doing business in Homer;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY HOMER ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 8.08.080 Exhibition of Licensee is hereby repealed in its entirety and reenacted to read as follows:

8.08.080 Exhibition of License. Persons licensed under this chapter shall [post ] display their licenses [for public display or wear the license on their person whereby the permit can be readily viewed by any citizen] as follows:

- a. All door to door vendors and persons soliciting or conducting business other than at a fixed business location shall physically wear their permit in plain view attached to their lapel, external jacket, or shirt, at all times while engaged in any business related public contact. (Note: Clip-on license holders are available for purchase at City Hall to assist vendor's compliance with this provision.)
- b. All other persons shall openly display their license at the front counter (or primary area of public contact) of their business.


c. All licensees shall produce their license for physical examination at the request of any citizen or peace officer authorized to enforce this chapter. (Ord. 88- , prior ordinance 86-21 S4, 1986)




