ORDINANCE 88-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER AMENDING CHAPTER 10.16, PORT RULES AND REGULATIONS BY AMENDING SECTION 10.16.202 (C) TO BECOME SECTION 10.16.202(D) AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 10.16.202(c).

WHEREAS, vehicle parking on the Homer Spit is limited during certain times of the year; and

WHEREAS, parking lot violations contribute to confusion and inconvenience to harbor users and visitors; and

WHEREAS, there are increasing demands for limited city owned property adjacent to the harbor, and

WHEREAS, area residents need reasonable parking space accessible to the harbor.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:


Section 1. Section 10.16.202(c) is hereby renumbered to become Section 10.16.202(d).

Section 2. A new Section 10.16.202(c) is hereby added to read as follows:


Section 10.16.202(c). Residents of the Kachemak Bay area may register their vehicles with the Harbormaster and obtain an annual parking tag. If properly displayed, in the front window, the tag authorizes the vehicle to be parked in Port/Harbor 14 day parking lots without any time restrictions. Fee for the annual parking tag is \$60.00 per vehicle. Owners of vessels with an annual registration are eligible to receive one vehicle tag for \$10.00.




