ORDINANCE 90-20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING SECTION 1.74.010 OF THE HOMER CITY CODE, TO ALLOW FOR UP TO THREE MEMBERS OF THE SEVEN MEMBER HOMER PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION, TO BE FROM OUTSIDE THE HOMER CITY LIMITS GIVING PREFERENCE TO CITY OF HOMER RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, the Homer Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission by-laws were recently amended to expand the Commission's jurisdiction to extra territorial interests, such as trails and city properties; and

WHEREAS, there is much interest shown from outside the immediate City Limits toward the Parks and Recreation Commission and the Commission's activities; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission serves the greater Homer Community; and

WHEREAS, there has presently been a vacancy on the Commission for several months with the only solid applicant being from outside the City limits and there are already two members on the Commission who are not residents of the City of Homer; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor finds it difficult to fill these vacancies with Homer residents and has requested Council's consideration in the matter; and

WHEREAS, four (4) members constitutes a quorum and four affirmative votes are required to pass a motion.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Subsection 1.74.010 (a) of the Homer City Code is hereby amended to read as follows.

a. There is created the City of Homer Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission, hereinafter referred to as the Commission. Such Commission will be made up of seven members, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. [One member of the Commission may be a resident from outside the city.] Up to three members of the Commission may be residents from outside the City, but preference shall be given to City resident applicants.
