AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA,
AMENDING TITLE 4, ELECTIONS, TO PROVIDE FOR
TWENTY DAYS NOTICE OF REGULAR AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS

THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Subparagraph a. of section 4.04.050 of the Homer City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

a. The City Clerk shall post the notice of each regular and special election in three public places and publish it at least twice in one or more newspapers of general circulation in the City. The first such publication shall be accomplished at least twenty days prior to the election and the last notice is to be accomplished within the week prior to the election.

Section 2. This is a general ordinance of a permanent nature and the provisions of Section 1 as contained herein shall be codified for inclusion in the Homer City Code.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall pre-clear the provisions of this ordinance with the U.S. Department of Justice pursuant to the Federal Voting Rights Act.
