ORDINANCE 91-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER,
ALASKA, AMENDING HOMER CITY CODE, TITLE 21, ZONING AND
PLANNING, CHAPTER 21.60, SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission requested that Chapter 21.60, Supplemental Regulations, Table 1, Permitted Signs by Type and Zoning District, Subparagraph (i) be amended to exclude flags from size and height restrictions; and,

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission requested that Chapter 21.60, Supplemental Regulations, Table 2, Maximum Total Sign Area Per Zone Lot by Zoning District, Subparagraph (b) be amended to exclude flags from size and height restrictions; and,

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission held a public hearing on the matter on May 8, 1991, as required by Homer City Code, Section 21.70.020.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Table 1 (i) be amended to read as follows:

(i). Flags of the United States, the state, the city, foreign nations having diplomatic relations with the United States and any other flag adopted or sanctioned by an elected legislative body of competent jurisdiction. [~~provided-that-such-a-flag-shall-not-exceed-60-square-feet-in-area-and-shall-not-be-flown-from-a-pole-the-top-of-which-is-more-than-40-feet~~] These flags must be flown in accordance with protocol established by the Congress of the United States for the Stars and Stripes. Any flag not meeting any one or more of these conditions shall be considered a banner sign and shall be subject to regulations as such.

Section 2. Table 2 (b) be amended to read as follows:

(b). Flags of the United States, the state, the city, foreign nations having diplomatic relations with the United States and any other flag adopted or sanctioned by an elected legislative body of competent jurisdiction. [~~provided-that-such-a-flag-shall-not-exceed-60-square-feet-in-area-and-shall-not-be-flown-from-a-pole-the-top-of-which-is-more-than-40-feet~~] These flags must be flown in accordance with protocol established by the Congress of the United States for the Stars and Stripes. Any flag not meeting any one or more of these conditions shall be considered a banner sign and shall be subject to regulations as such.


