## ORDINANCE 92-02(A)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA, AMENDING CHAPTER 10.18 OF THE HOMER CITY CODE, PORT TARIFF RATES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Port and Harbor Commission has submitted various recommendations to off set Harbor expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the following are recommended increases.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 10.18.210, Petroleum products wharfage, A wharfage of one cent (\$.01) per gallon [\$:005-per-gallon] will be assessed against petroleum products passing or conveyed over any City port facility, whether a wharf, pier, ramp, dock or beach. The wharfage fee assessed by this section shall be applied to cargo and freight as described in Section 10.16.100 and to fuel dispensed to a vessel by a distributor or dealer; it shall not apply to fuel intended for use by a vessel which is carried on board the vessel by the vessel's owner or operator, eg., five gallon containers.
