AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA, AMENDING SECTION 10.12.030 OF THE HOMER CITY CODE, HARBOR FEES, MOORING ASSIGNMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Port and Harbor Commission has submitted various recommendations to off set Harbor expenditures; and

WHEREAS, it is the Port and Harbor Commission's intent to increase all moorage fees by eleven percent (11%); and

WHEREAS, the following are recommended increases.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 10.12.030. Mooring rates, (b)(1) of the Homer City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

b. 1. ~~{The annual moorage fee for reserved moorage and transient moorage privileges shall be eighteen dollars per lineal foot}~~ The transient moorage, annual moorage and semi-annual moorage fees shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) per lineal foot, based on the length of the float assigned or the overall length of the vessel (including all hull attachments such as bowsprits, davits, dinghies, etc.), whichever is greater.

Section 2. Section 10.12.030. Mooring rates, (b)(2) of the Homer City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

b.2. The monthly transient rate for the period of October through April will be two dollars and ~~{fifty}~~ seventy seven cents per foot per month. Vessels that are properly registered and pay all fees in advance will be charged two dollars per foot per month.

Section 3. Section 10.12.030 Mooring rates, (b)(3) of the Homer City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

b.3. The monthly transient rate for the period May through September will be three dollars and ~~{fifty}~~ eighty eight cents per foot per month. Vessels that are properly registered and pay all fees in advance will be charged three dollars per foot per month.

Section 4. Section 10.12.030 Mooring rates, (c) of the Homer City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

c. Transient daily vessels shall be charged at the following rates including taxes:

Vessels that properly register and pay all moorage fees in advance may deduct five dollars per day from the daily rate.
