## ORDINANCE 92-30(S)(A)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOMER AMENDING SECTION 1.40.020, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, ALLOWING FOR HONORARY AND/OR EX-OFFICIO MEMBERS.

The City Council of the City of Homer, Alaska hereby ordains that:

1.40.020 Boards and Commissions. Boards and Commissions may be created or abolished by Council action. The number of members of each board or commission, their terms of office and purpose for which they are created shall be determined by resolution of the City Council or by ordinance. Appointment and removal of the members of boards and commissions shall be by recommendation of the Mayor and confirmation of such action by the City Council, except as may otherwise be specifically provided for in the Statutes of the State of Alaska and/or under other provisions of the City Code. In addition to the voting members of the board or commission the Mayor may appoint Honorary members of the board or commission, subject to confirmation by the City Council, and honorary member term to be determined at the time of appointment. Honorary members of the board or commission may participate in the deliberation/s of the board or commission, but may not vote, nor shall they be counted in determining whether a quorum is present.

This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall be included in the Homer City Code.
