ORDINANCE 96-01

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOMER AMENDING
HOMER CITY CODE SECTION 1.24.070 TO ESTABLISH
PROCEDURES RELATING TO THE MAYOR'S VETO**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HOMER:

Section 1. Homer City Code Section 1.24.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:

a. Except as provided in this section, the Mayor may veto an ordinance, resolution, motion, or other action of the City Council and may strike or reduce appropriation items.

b. A veto must be exercised before the next regular meeting of the City Council. ~~and~~ A veto must be signed by the mayor and be accompanied by a written explanation of the reasons for the veto. A veto that is not signed or that fails to include a written explanation of the reasons for the veto is ineffective. A veto may be overridden by vote of two-thirds of the authorized membership of the City Council within twenty-one days following exercise of the veto, or at the next regular meeting, whichever is later. The City Council shall first consider a veto override at the first regular or special council meeting, not including work sessions, that occurs following the veto, but the City Council may postpone taking action from time to time until the expiration of the time for override specified in the preceding sentence.

c. The veto does not extend to:

1. Actions of the City Council sitting as the Board of Adjustment;
2. Adoption or repeal of a Manager plan of government;
3. The veto does not extend to an ordinance adopted under AS 04.11.501, ~~AS 04.11.498~~.


Section 2. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be included in the City Code.


