ORDINANCE 96-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER AMENDING CHAPTER 14.08 OF THE CITY CODE SUBPARAGRAPH 14.08.035(f), ONE TIME FEE FOR PRESSURE REDUCING VALVES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 90-10 added subparagraph 14.08.035(f) making provision for fee and/or maintenance for pressure reducing valves; and

WHEREAS, the fees contained within the ordinance are no longer accurate and due to the fluctuation of the cost of pressure reducing valves it is in the best interest of the City that the fee be actual cost plus fifteen percent for all sizes.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Subparagraph 14.08.035(f) of the Homer City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

f. A one-time fee for a pressure reducing valve (PRV), when required by 13.28.050(e), shall be ~~established follows:~~

<del>3/4"</del>	<del>\$ 43.00</del>
<del>1"</del>	<del>66.00</del>
<del>1 1/2"</del>	<del>153.00</del>
<del>2"</del>	<del>217.00</del>

~~Fees for pressure reducing valves larger than two inches shall be actual costs plus fifteen percent as determined by the Public Works Director.~~

The City will maintain the pressure reducing valves. The customer shall pay for such maintenance only if the valve is damaged because the customer allowed it to freeze or as a result of negligent or intentional acts or omissions of the customer.


Section 2. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be included in the City code.


