ORDINANCE 98 - 20(A)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HOMER, ALASKA AMENDING REVENUE AND FINANCE,
BUDGET, SECTION 3.05.015, REVIEW; HEARING; ADOPTION;
APPROPRIATIONS ~~AND SECTION 3.05.045, BALANCED~~
BUDGET REQUIREMENTS, OF THE HOMER CITY CODE.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Homer City Code Section 3.05.015, Review; hearing; adoption;
appropriations, is hereby amended to read to as follows:

3.05.015 Review; hearing; adoption; appropriations. a. The budget proposal of the City
Manager shall be reviewed by the Council and shall be available for public inspection in the office
of the City Clerk: **and the budget summary shall be posted in three public places and published
at least once in one or more newspapers of general circulation in the City.**

b. A public hearing on the appropriation ordinance shall be held in accordance with
provisions for adoption of an ordinance. All interested parties shall be given an opportunity to be
heard on matters relative to the budget.

c. At a Council meeting held not less than ten days prior to the end of the fiscal year, the
Council shall, by ordinance, make appropriation of the money needed for the following year.

d. A separate appropriation shall be made to each of the various funds of the City. From the
effective date of the budget, the amounts stated therein as proposed expenditures, shall be and
become appropriated to the objects and purposes therein named. The City Council may make
supplemental and emergency appropriations, but payment may not be authorized or made and an
obligation may not be incurred except in accordance with approved appropriations.

~~Section 2. Homer City Code Section 3.05.045, Balanced budget requirements, is hereby
amended to read as follows:~~

~~3.05.045 Balanced budget requirements. The budget which is adopted shall be balanced
considering all sources of funds. **and projected budget expenditures shall not exceed projected
budget revenues.**~~

~~a. Any action to reconsider, rescind, or veto the budget which creates an "imbalance" shall
be in violation of this section.~~


~~b. Any action to reconsider, rescind, or veto the budget which would affect a balanced
budget must be accompanied by action which maintains a balanced budget.~~

Section 3.2. This ordinance is of a permanent and general character and shall be included
in the City code




