ORDINANCE 99-7

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HOMER AMENDING HOMER CITY CODE SECTION 7.08.021
BY REPEALING SUBSECTIONS B AND C.

WHEREAS, the Homer District Court has found that subsection 7.08.021(b) is invalid and unenforceable pursuant to AS § 28.01.010; and

WHEREAS, the Homer Police Department recommends that sub section 7.08.021(b) be repealed; and

WHEREAS, upon study and review the City Attorney recommends that subsection 7.08.021(c) also be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 7.08.021, Starting parked vehicles is hereby amended by repealing subsection b. to read as follows:

7.08.021 Starting parked vehicles. a. A person may not move onto roadway, a vehicle which is stopped, standing or parked until the movement can be made with reasonable safety.

~~b. No person may accelerate a vehicle which is stopped, standing or parked on or along a street or which is entering a street so rapidly as to unnecessarily cause the tires to squeal or spin in such a manner as to throw sand, rocks or gravel or leave black marks on the road surface.~~

~~c. No person shall enter or drive upon any street in such a manner which causes the driver to lose control of the vehicle or causes the vehicle to "fishtail". (Ord. 83-12 §1, 1983.)~~

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption by the Homer City Council.




