RESOLUTION 84-103 (A)

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT PRIORITIES FOR FY 1986.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on September 24, 1984 to hear comments on a six year community-wide capital improvement program; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 8, 1984 to hear comments on the recommended FY 86 capital improvement priorities; and,

WHEREAS, upon recommendation by the Governor's office, projects of a local and regional nature have been prioritized on a single list; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council to provide the Governor and legislative delegation from District 5 with adequate information to represent the desire of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the following capital improvement projects are identified as the City of Homer Priority List for FY 1986 with funding level needs as respectfully submitted:

1. Upper and Lower Main Street - Pave/Storm/Sidewalks	\$2,500,000
2. East Hill Road Reconstruction - Phase II	5,300,000
3. Sewer Treatment Plant Construction	2,062,000
4. Harbor Float Expansion and Equipment	4,140,000
5. Kachemak Way - Pave/Sidewalks	525,000
6. Fairview Ave/Bartlett St. to East Rd. - Pave/Sidewalks	2,350,000
7. Heath St/Fairview Ave. to Bypass - Pave/Sidewalks	1,320,000
8. Homer Spit Waterline Reconstruction - Phase I	820,000
9. Homer Barge Dock	1,500,000
10. Bartlett Street - Reconstruct Road/Sidewalks	1,100,000
11. Kachemak Bay Drive - Design and ROW Acquisition	1,000,000
12. Pratt Museum - Renovate and Expand	2,150,000
13. Campground (Hillside Park) - Renovate	277,000
14. South Peninsula Hospital	2,969,000
