A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SOUTH  
PENINSULA HOSPITAL'S CERTIFICATE  
OF NEED APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, there are a rapidly increasing number of people in need of long term nursing care in Homer and the South Kenai Peninsula area, and

WHEREAS, there is a severe shortage of long term nursing care beds in the South Kenai Peninsula area, and

WHEREAS, patients in need of long term nursing care generally must leave the South Kenai Peninsula area and consequently suffer separation from their family, friends, and community, and

WHEREAS, the South Peninsula Hospital has submitted a certificate of need application to the State of Alaska Office of Health Planning and Development, Department of Health and Social Services to construct a sixty bed long term nursing care facility,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the City of Homer supports the South Peninsula Hospital's certificate of need application to construct a sixty bed nursing home in Homer.
