RESOLUTION 84-73

A RESOLUTION FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE THE HEATH STREET WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA

WHEREAS, there is a need for water service on Heath Street as a result of the anticipated improvements to the area and it is in the interest of good health and the general welfare to have a water system; and,

WHEREAS, on April 23, 1984, a Resolution ⁸⁴83-33, finding the need to create the Heath Street Water Improvement District and setting the date for public hearing was passed, and a public hearing was held May 29, 1984 and


WHEREAS, on July 1, 1984, sixty days or more following the public hearing, there have not been objections raised by owners of property who shall bear one-half of the estimated cost of the improvement; or objections from property owners representing more than 50% of the assessed property valuation,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, that the Council does determine that the improvement is necessary and should be made, in accordance with HCC 17.04.060 of the Homer City Code, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that assessment financing be afforded to the property owners via a 5 year payment term.
