RESOLUTION 85- 1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF CASH
REWARDS FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE ARREST
OR INDICTMENT OF PERSONS VANDALIZING CITY PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer has on on-going problem with vandalism of municipal property and equipment, and


WHEREAS, this vandalism has caused considerable financial damage to the city and potentially endangers the health, safety and welfare of Homer area residents,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that the City Manager is authorized to pay cash rewards of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest or indictment of the person or persons vandalizing city property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount of the reward offered for any act of vandalism shall be commensurate with the extent of damages done and/or the danger to the safety, health and welfare of the public. This amount of reward shall be set by a three person panel consisting of (1) the City Manager, (2) a Councilmember and (3) the head of the city department most impacted by the act of vandalism.
