RESOLUTION 85-10

A RESOLUTION FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE THE EAST HILL ROAD SEWER AND WATER SERVICE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA AND SETTING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, there is a need for sewer service on East Hill Road, and it is in the interest of good health and the general welfare of the public to have a sewer system; and,

WHEREAS, the State intends to reconstruct and pave East Hill Road in the summer of 1985, and the costs of extending a new sewer line and providing water services to now-vacant lots would be prohibitive after the road's reconstruction; and,

WHEREAS, property owners along East Hill Road have submitted statements of interest in an East Hill Road sewer line in numbers which are sufficient to warrant initiation of a sewer improvement district; and,

WHEREAS, the City intends to request a matching grant for the East Hill Road sewer project from the State of Alaska,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the Council does determine that the sewer and water service improvements are necessary and should be made, in accordance with the HCC 17.04.050; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the intent of the City of Homer to form such improvement district and that a public hearing will be held during the regular City Council meeting of Monday, March 11, 1985, at Homer City Hall, at 7:30 p.m., for the purpose of hearing protests against the formation of said improvement district; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to compile the necessary information on the cost of the improvement and to begin to prepare plans for the improvement in order to notify the property owners of such cost and the date of the hearing publication as required by law.
