RESOLUTION 85-14

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CONTINUED SUPPORT
FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE BRADLEY LAKE HYDRO-
ELECTRIC POWER PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Homer, Alaska have long supported the Bradley Lake Hydroelectric Power Project, and;

WHEREAS, there has been phenomenal growth of industry and consumers on the Kenai Peninsula requiring large amounts of power, and;

WHEREAS, Bradley Lake has long been noted as being economically and environmentally sound for the production of hydroelectric power, and;

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has set \$450,000,000 aside for funding of the Susitna and Bradley hydroelectric projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the \$450,000,000 for Bradley and Susitna hydroelectric projects be identified or dedicated as energy funds to protect these funds from being raided as capital for other projects.


