A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE POSITION OF
BUILDING INSPECTOR FOR THE CITY OF HOMER.

WHEREAS, the Life and Safety Committee doing the study on the above study has not finished their report to the City Council,

WHEREAS, the actual decision to employ one in this position should be decided only after the committee report is concluded,

WHEREAS, the vote by the Homer City Council on February 11, 1985 on employment of a Building Inspector is henceforth overturned,

WHEREAS, well over 100 Homer citizens have signed petitions, (an earnest request) against a Building Inspector,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska urges and supports the delay of any further action to employ anyone in the position of Building Inspector until after the Life and Safety Committee has finished their report.
