RESOLUTION 85-32

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING ADOPTION OF HOUSE BILL 272 PERTAINING TO ABSENTEE VOTING IN PERSON FOR STATE ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, HB 272 provides that the division of elections shall provide absentee voting in person for eight hours a day, seven days a week for the two weeks that precede a primary, general, or special election of the state in municipalities of 1,000 or more population,

WHEREAS, the office of municipal clerk of such municipalities generally provide absentee voting in person for state elections,

WHEREAS, the municipality agrees that absentee voters should have every opportunity to vote in primary, general and special elections,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Homer City Council opposes the passage of HB 273 without provisions to compensate the municipality of Homer for services provided the Division of Elections.
