RESOLUTION 85-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA AUTHORIZING A DISPOSAL AREA FOR DREDGING MATERIAL.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer is required to provide, without cost, to the United States all lands, easements and rights-of-way necessary for the construction and subsequent maintenance of the Homer Small Boat Harbor; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that 12,000 to 15,000 cubic yards of material must be dredged annually to maintain the harbor entrance; and

WHEREAS, the placement of the material should coincide with the recent Port/Harbor facilities plan update; and

WHEREAS, the Port and Harbor Commission, at its regular meeting of March 13, 1985, voted unanimously to recommend placement of the harbor entrance maintenance dredged materials;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that future harbor entrance maintenance dredged materials be placed on the southerly end of the 30-acre fill adjacent to the harbor entrance;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this recommendation be forwarded to the Department of the Army, U.S. Army Engineers and all steps necessary to accomplish this action be taken by the City Manager.
