A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF BOROUGH FUNDING  
OF 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE DISPATCH SERVICES  
FOR 234, 235, 281 AND 284 EXCHANGES.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer is presently administering and dispatching emergency services for calls received on the 911 emergency line from the 234 and 235 exchanges, and

WHEREAS, many of the calls received and services provided at city expense are from callers outside the corporate limits of the City of Homer, and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer is additionally willing to administer and dispatch 911 calls from the 284 (Port Graham) and 281 (English Bay) exchanges,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that the Kenai Peninsula Borough provide funding to the City of Homer to allow the city to continue to provide services to the hereabove referenced borough service areas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said funding shall consist of all costs (salary and benefits) equal to one full-time clerk/dispatch position within the Department of Public Safety.
