A RESOLUTION FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE AN
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO STRIP KACHEMAK WAY
FROM BAYVIEW AVENUE TO PIONEER AVENUE

WHEREAS, Kachemak Way from Bayview Avenue to Pioneer Avenue has
been built to City standards;

WHEREAS, strip paving is an economic and viable method of
retaining the integrity of reconstructed and upgraded roads while
providing dust control;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the intent of the City
of Homer to form an improvement district to strip pave Kachemak Way
from Bayview Avenue to Pioneer Avenue and that a Public Hearing will
be held on Monday, July 8, 1985 at Homer City Hall, 7:30 PM for the
purpose of hearing comments or objections to the formation of such
improvement district;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to
compile the necessary information on the cost of the improvement and
to begin to prepare plans for the improvement in order to notify the
property owners of such cost and the date of the hearing and to have
notice of the hearing published as required by law.
