A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA,
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC
FACILITIES TO CORRECT THE SAFETY PROBLEM AT MILE
1 OF EAST END ROAD, HOMER, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the Ad Hoc Street Light and Crosswalk Committee has identified a serious highway safety problem currently existing at Mile 1 East End Road in Homer, more specifically at the corner of East End Road and Rochelle Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT/PF) has been contacted and requested to resolve this safety problem as a maintenance matter; and

WHEREAS, DOT/PF has advised the City that they concur a safety problem does indeed exist but that the problem is beyond the level of any maintenance and operations effort and should be more properly addressed as part of the Department's Capital Improvement Program (CIP).


