RESOLUTION 85-76

RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL  
MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF OCTOBER 1, 1985

WHEREAS, in compliance with the HCC 4.04.190, the Canvass Board of the City of Homer has opened, counted, and tallied the votes on absentee ballots and made determinations on questioned ballots, and has opened, counted, and tallied those questioned ballots found to be valid, cast in the General Municipal Election held on October 1, 1985; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with HCC 4.04.190, the Canvass Board of the City of Homer has opened and inspected the precinct reports, and entered the results of the absentee and questioned ballots on the Certification of Election along with the results of the precinct counts;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska, that the Council hereby accepts and certifies the results of the General Municipal Election for the City of Homer held October 1, 1985, as presented in the Certificate of Election by the Canvass Board, in accordance with the Homer City Code;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following candidates, having received at least 40% of the votes cast for their respective offices, are hereby declared elected:

COUNCILMEMBER - THREE YEAR TERM - Pat Evarts  
COUNCILMEMBER - THREE YEAR TERM - John Kosch

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Proposition A, "Shall the City of Homer by enactment of an ordinance so providing continue to set the property tax mill levy at an annual rate of six mills or less through levy of a two percent sales tax on all sales, rents and services within the City, except as the same may be otherwise exempted by law. The revenues from the sales tax shall be placed in the General Fund. Voter authorization for the two percent sales tax shall only remain in effect for those years that the City Council sets the property mill levy at six mills or less. Should the proposition be disapproved by the voters at this election, the existing sales tax will continue in full force and effect until June 30, 1986, after which it shall cease to be levied" was approved by the voters;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of the Certificate of Election be permanently attached as part of this resolution.
