RESOLUTION 85-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING
MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY FOR PIONEER AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer has reconstructed Pioneer Avenue from the Sterling Highway to Lake Street, a distance of approximately 5100 feet and such construction has included sidewalks and landscaping; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities snow removal crews are equipped primarily for maintenance of highways rather than urban streets such as Pioneer Avenue has now become; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the City of Homer is in the position to provide a higher level of maintenance and snow removal than required in the past; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has offered to provide funding to the City of Homer in the amount of \$8000 per lane mile for a total of \$24,000 per year to assume maintenance responsibility for Pioneer Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a maintenance agreement with the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities in which the City of Homer accepts maintenance responsibilities of Pioneer Avenue between the Sterling Highway and Lake Street for an annual payment of \$24,000, for the year 1985/86.
