A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE HOMER SPIT WATERLINE REPLACEMENT (SCHEDULE "A" - PHASE I) CONTRACT TO HERNDON & HERNDON, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$415,954.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Homer did duly and properly advertise the HOMER SPIT WATERLINE REPLACEMENT (SCHEDULE "A" - PHASE I); and

WHEREAS, the City held a public bid opening for the above described project on October 3, 1985 at 2:00 PM at Homer City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder was the firm of HERNDON & HERNDON, INC.; and
