RESOLUTION 85-84

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF HOMER CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION ON
NOVEMBER 26, 1985, IN ORDER TO ELECT A MAYOR
TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF OFFICE

WHEREAS, the term of mayor is two years, with the current term to
expire on October 20, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Wayne Kessler is resigning his term of office,
effective October 15, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the next regular election is not scheduled until October
7, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.23.28 requires that a special election
be called by the City Council in order to fill an unexpired term of
office when a vacancy in the office of mayor occurs more than six
months before a regular election;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City
of Homer calls for a special election to be held on November 26, 1985,
the purpose of which will be to elect a mayor to fill the unexpired
term of office.
