A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FILING OF STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR THE EAST HILL ROAD SEWER, SEWER TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION, HOMER EAST ROAD TIE-IN AND STERLING HIGHWAY WATER AND SEWER.


WHEREAS, four City of Homer projects meet requisite Department of Environmental Conservation requirements for grant applications, those being:
