**A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
SUPPORTING THE KACHEMAK GUN CLUB**

WHEREAS, the Homer area is one of hunters and gun enthusiasts, and;

WHEREAS, there is a definite need for an organized and controlled shooting range within the area, and;

WHEREAS, it is important to maintain a supervised area in which to teach gun and shooting safety, and;

WHEREAS, a regularly scheduled Hunter Safety Program for our youngsters should be encouraged, and;

WHEREAS, recreational shooters require a location for safe shooting, and;

WHEREAS, the existing rifle range at 10 Mile Sterling Highway is controlled by the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Recreation in conjunction with the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, and;

WHEREAS, the existing rifle range is not likely to remain a shooting range due to the inadequacy of the range itself relative to size, and the plans of the agencies involved to include this parcel of land in an expanded Anchor River Wayside, and;

WHEREAS, the existing recreational trap shooting range is privately owned and will not be available for shooters for any determined time, and;

WHEREAS, there is no other location within the area that is designated as a shooting range, and;

WHEREAS, the Kachemak Gun Club, a non-profit organization recognized by the State of Alaska, has undertaken to organize, establish, control, and maintain a shooting range for the benefit of all area residents:

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Homer, Alaska, supports the Kachemak Gun Club in its efforts to locate, establish and maintain a shooting range for the benefit of all shooters residing in and around the City of Homer;


