A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF HOMER ENDORSING THE KACHEMAK
BAY STATE PARK LAND EXCHANGE WITH THE
SELDOVIA NATIVE ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Kachemak Bay State Park has been created to protect and preserve the natural environment of the area and provide recreational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the formation of Kachemak Bay State Park will guarantee that future generations will be able to enjoy and appreciate the beauty and surroundings of the area; and


WHEREAS, in an effort to restore the heart of the park, consolidate parcels of land contained in the Park and provide continuity and consistency therein, the Seldovia Native Association and the State Department of Natural Resources have negotiated a land exchange; and

WHEREAS, the proposed land exchange is an equitable and mutually beneficial transaction for both the Seldovia Native Association and the Kachemak Bay State Park.


