RESOLUTION 87-75

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE THE WEST RANGEVIEW AVENUE PAVING IMPROVEMENT AREA AND SETTING A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has adopted the Homer Accelerated Road Reconstruction Program, and

WHEREAS, a majority of the voters of the City of Homer approved Proposition #2 for an increased sales tax rate for street reconstruction and related utilities; and

WHEREAS, Rangeview Avenue falls within the guidelines of the Homer Accelerated Road Programs as a Group II, subdivision road built to City standards; and


WHEREAS, a petition for the paving of West Rangeview was initiated by one of the property owners and submitted with 56% of the value of property to be benefited property owners signatures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that it is the intent of the City to form such an improvement area and that a public hearing will be held during the regular City Council meeting of Monday, January 11th, 1988 at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of hearing protests against the formation of said improvement area;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to compile the necessary information, boundaries and begin to prepare plans for the improvement in order to notify the property owners of such cost and the date of the hearing publicized as required by law.
