RESOLUTION 89-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF THE JENNY LANE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION/PAVING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH THE PREPARATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the formation of the Jenny Lane Road Reconstruction/paving Improvement District was contingent upon the construction of a water line prior to the authorization of a road reconstruction and paving improvement;

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council authorized the formation of the Jenny Lane Water Line extension improvement District and authorized the City Manager to proceed with preparations for construction of the project;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held September 12, 1988 to hear objections or protests to the formation of such an improvement district after property owners of the district were duly notified by certified mailing of such hearing and legal notice of hearing being advertised; and

WHEREAS, the objection deadline for written protest was November 18, 1988 and (3) written protests were received equalling 24% of the total property owner project cost; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the improvement is desired by the property owners who equal more than one-half of the total project cost;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the Jenny Lane Road Reconstruction/Paving Improvement District is hereby created and formed, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is instructed to proceed with the necessary preparations and construction of the improvement district and to prepare the final assessment roll for presentation to the Homer City Council at a future date.
