A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE CONTRACT #4, SPIT COLLECTION SYSTEM - PUMP STATIONS/FORCE MAIN TO THE FIRM OF BROWN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,973,568.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, The City of Homer held a public bid opening on February 24, 1989 at 2:00 p.m. at Homer City Hall for work as described in the contract documents, and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive bidder was the firm of Brown Construction Company, Inc., and


WHEREAS, R.W. Beck, engineer, made recommendation to accept Brown Construction Company, Inc.'s, bid;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that Contract #4, Spit Collection System - Pump Stations/Force Main is awarded to the firm of Brown Construction Company, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,973,568.00 and that the City Manager is authorized to sign the appropriate documents.
