RESOLUTION 89-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING A GRANT OFFER FROM THE UNITED STATES FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,000.00 FOR INSTALLATION OF A DOLPHIN IN THE HOMER SMALL BOAT HARBOR AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the M/V TIGLAX is home ported in the Homer Small Boat Harbor and requires the installation of power that can best be facilitated by installing a dolphin, creating a permanent berth, at an estimated cost of \$22,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer has been requested to install such a dolphin with the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service reimbursing the Port of Homer \$22,000.00 for such installation, and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed and favorably recommended by the Port and Harbor Advisory Commission at their regular meeting held January 18, 1989;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council authorize the City Manager to accept the grant offer in the amount of \$22,000.00 from the United States Fish and Wildlife Services and agrees to all conditions thereof and authorizes the City Manager to sign the appropriate agreement.
