A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL IN SUPPORT OF CONTINUED CURRENT FUNDING FOR THE F.R.E.D. DIVISION OF THE FISH & GAME.

WHEREAS, commercial and recreational salmon fishing are one of the most important sectors of the Homer area economy; and

WHEREAS, the projects of the Fisheries Rehabilitation Enhancement and Development (F.R.E.D.) division of the Department of Fish & Game have contributed significantly to the total areas salmon harvest; and

WHEREAS, significant reductions in the F.R.E.D. Division budget are being proposed; and

WHEREAS, such reductions would cripple or eliminate many of the F.R.E.D. Division projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that the City of Homer requests that the Governor of Alaska and the Alaska State Legislature make no reductions in the F.R.E.D. Division budget and fully fund the valuable projects of this agency;

BE IT FURTHER Resolved that the City Manager is directed to send copies of this resolution to the Governor of the State of Alaska, Senator Paul Fischer, and Representatives Mike Navarre and C.E. Swackhammer.
