RESOLUTION 89-55(s)

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING CONTRACT #6, KACHEMAK WASTEWATER
FACILITY TO DOYLE CONSTRUCTION CO.,
HERNDON/THOMPSON, J.V. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$1,796,355.50 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, a bid opening was held for the Kachemak City
Wastewater Collection System, Phase I on April 7, 1989 at 3:00
p.m. after being duly advertised in accordance with Homer
Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder was the firm of Doyle
Construction Co., and Herndon & Thompson, joint venture; and

WHEREAS, partial funding of the construction of the project
is from a Federal grant from E.P.A. (C-020113-01); and

WHEREAS, a letter of protest was filed with E.P.A. by the
unsuccessful bidders claiming a conflict of interest by the Mayor
of the City of Homer;

WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has
rendered a Determination of the Regional Administrator Pursuant
to 40 CFR 3 ss 33.1145, BP NO. 1089-04-23-206 in the matter of
City of Homer Alaska; Kachemak City Wastewater Collection System
Project (Protest of Tam Construction and Zubeck, Inc.) dismissing
their protest appeal;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council,
that based upon the determination and subject to the decision by
E.P.A. that the Kachemak City Wastewater Collection System
Project, Phase I is hereby awarded to the firm of Doyle
Construction Co. and Herndon/Thompson, J.V. in an amount not to
exceed \$1,796,355.50 and authorizes the City Manager to sign the
appropriate documents.
