A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL  
ADOPTING THE DETERMINATION OF POPULATION OF  
THE MUNICIPALITY AS OF JULY, 1, 1989.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Community & Regional Affairs is charged by statute with determining the population of the municipality for State Revenue Sharing purposes; and

WHEREAS, Department of Community and Regional Affairs has determined that for State Revenue Sharing Program purposes the population for the City of Homer is 4,338; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the municipality must pass a resolution adopting the results of the census for use by the Department of Community and Regional Affairs;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that on July 1, 1989 the population of permanent residents of the City of Homer was 4,338.
