A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING SUPPORT BY THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES FOR FUNDING CAPITAL PROJECT/LEGISLATIVE REQUESTS IN FISCAL YEAR 1991.

WHEREAS, building and maintaining safe, efficient and reliable transportation facilities is one of the most important responsibilities of state government, and

WHEREAS, projects eligible for federal funding leverage limited state dollars and should therefore be considered as priority projects, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to provide the Governor and Department of Transportation/Public Facilities information to represent the desires of the City concerning transportation projects as they affect the Homer area.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that the following transportation projects are identified as priority projects requiring support of the Governor's office as well as the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for funding in fiscal year 1991;


