A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING CAPITAL PROJECTS/LEGISLATIVE REQUEST FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991 AND REQUESTING APPROPRIATE FUNDING.

WHEREAS, a duly published hearing was held on October 23, 1989 in order to obtain public comments on recommended Fiscal Year 1989-94 capital improvement projects and legislative priorities; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to provide the Governor and legislative delegation from District 5 adequate information to represent the desires of the City concerning legislative requests including necessary funding requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that the following Capital Improvement Projects are identified as the City of Homer priority list for Legislative Request in Fiscal Year 1991:


